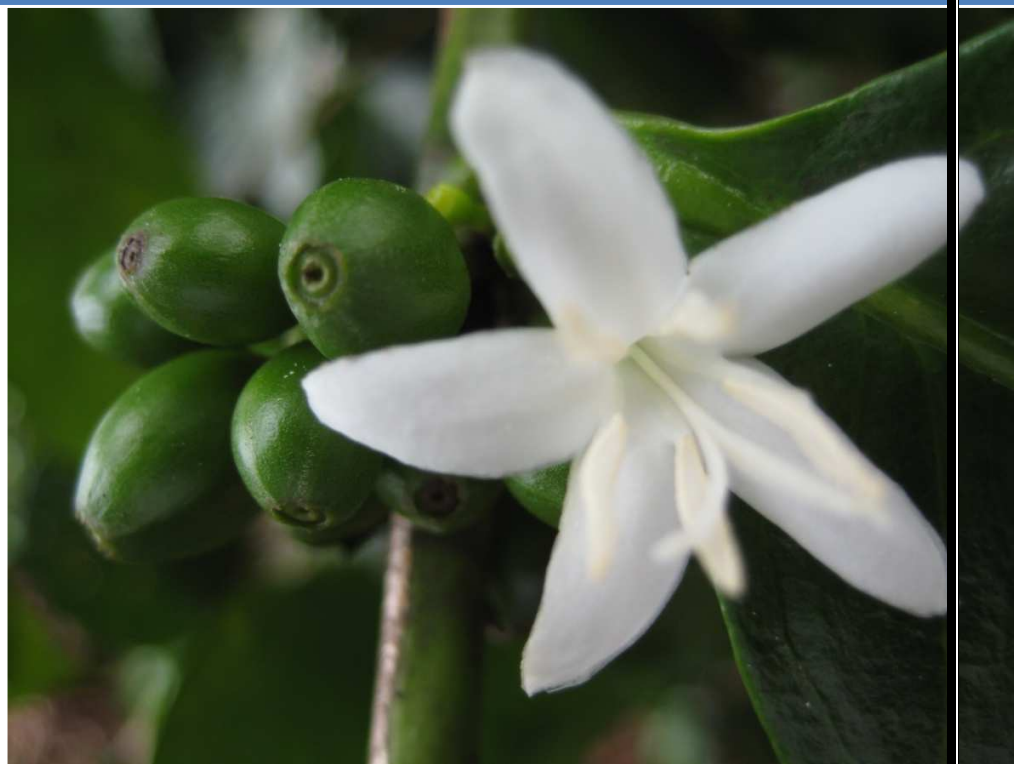




# Coffee report – 2008/09 Harvest

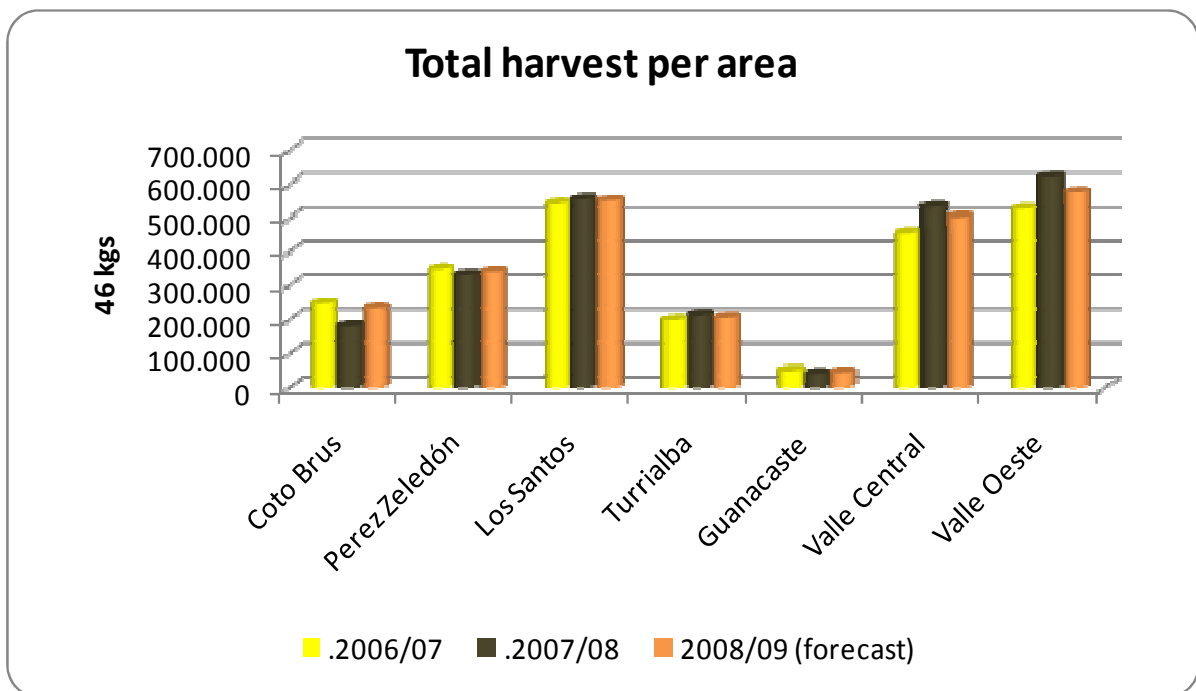


1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of October 2008

### 1. Harvest comments:

We are just ending 5 straight days of rains! I never saw so much rain falling all along the day and night.

Concerns about “Ojo de gallo” attack increased in the high areas and will have an impact next year.



Harvest is earlier than last year in most of the coffee regions. Tarrazu and the West valley, by definition the latest to begin with the harvest are already reporting the first picking and delivery.

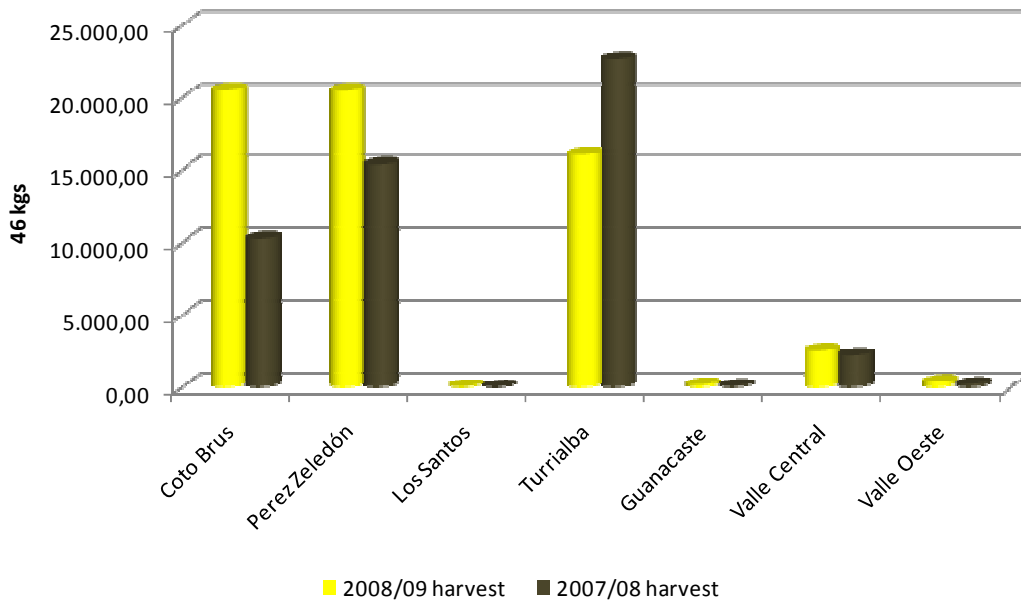
We are still planning to have an off cycle in the West valley and Turrialba.

We are planning to have an on cycle in Coto Brus and Perez Zeledón.

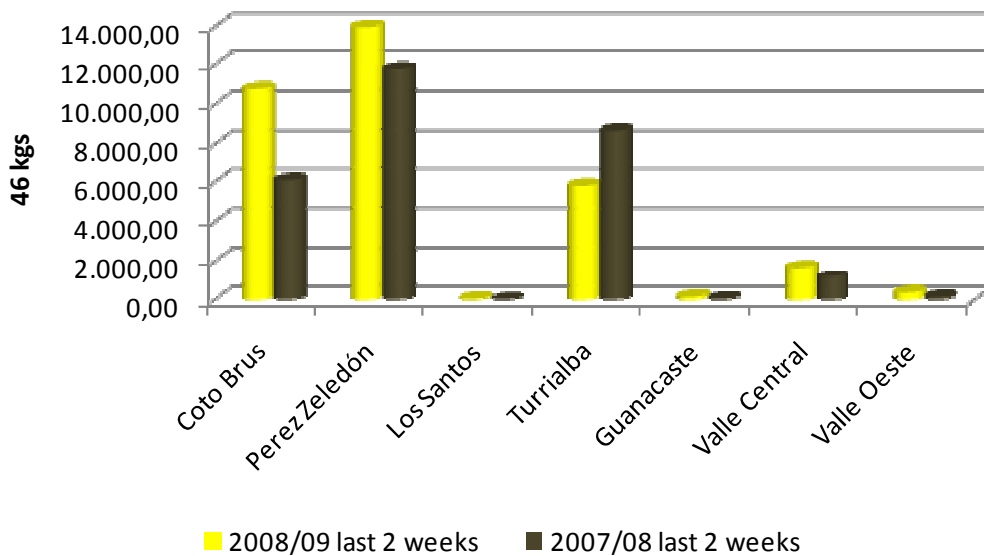
We are still uncertain with the Central valley and Los Santos and will need a few more weeks before betting on an on or off cycle.

## **2. Commercial activity:**

Credit lines are the big concern (out of the price!) as delay was reported. As the harvest is earlier and already flooding, the situation has to be urgently solved.

Our suppliers are on a total stand by for different reasons:

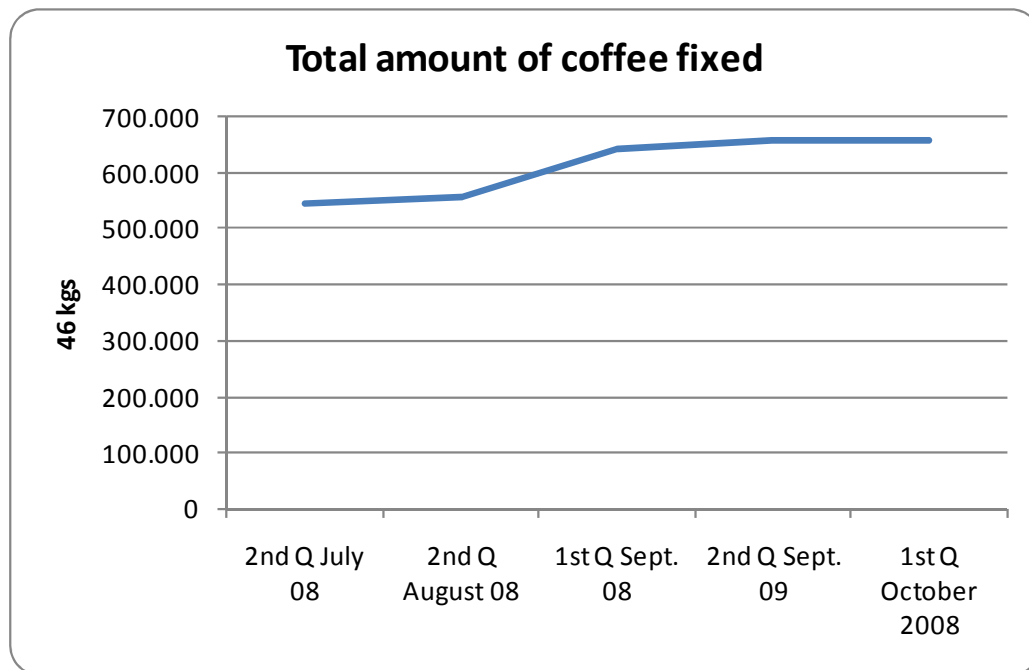
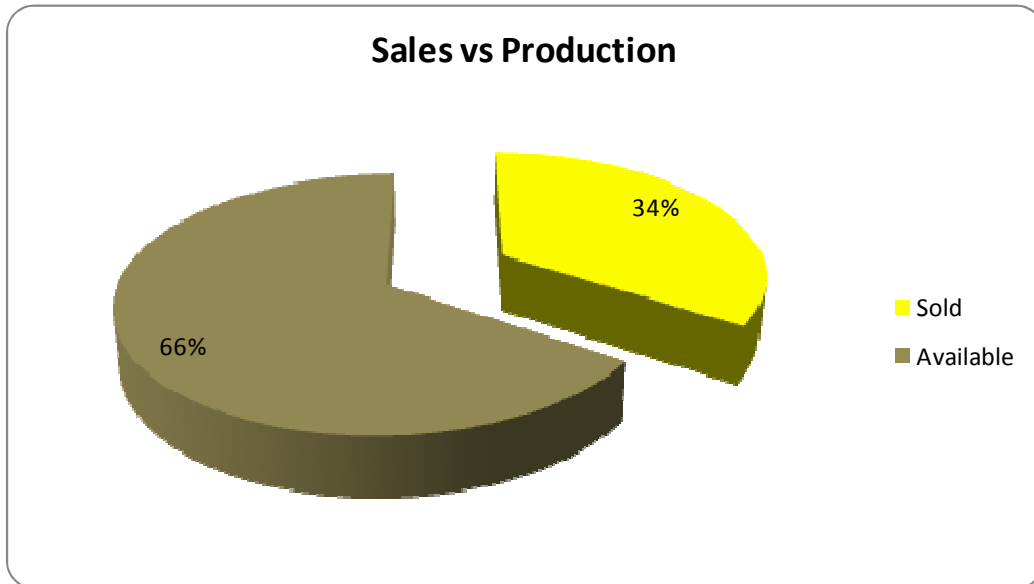
- High mainstream coffee sales for the first part of the year because of the Colombian situation;
- Early and higher sales vs last year: some are reported a 100% more sales vs the same date last year;
- Because of bad weather conditions, the “ojo de gallo” attack could cause a reduction of the harvest;
- Even if the harvest is earlier than last year, it will last one more month to have a better idea about the harvest potential and move to a second selling wave;

Because of that our suppliers do not feel the necessity to increase their commitment till mid -November.

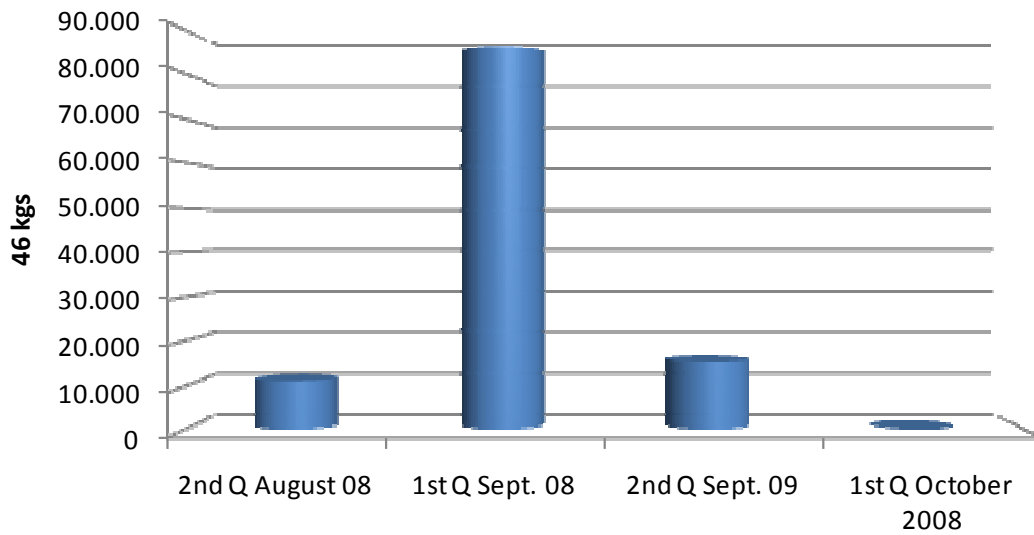
So we are almost out of the market for the moment.



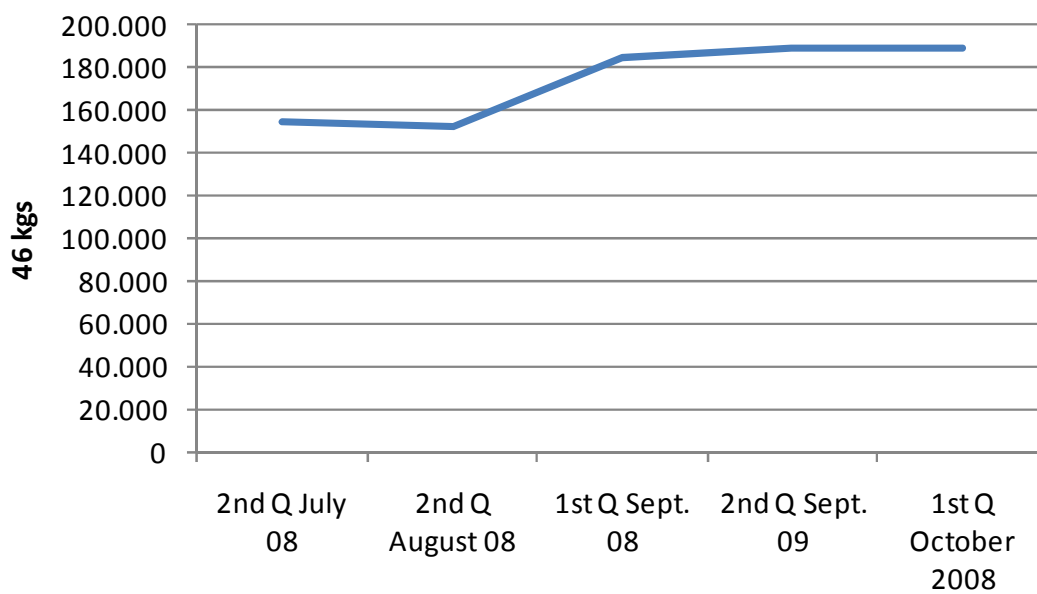

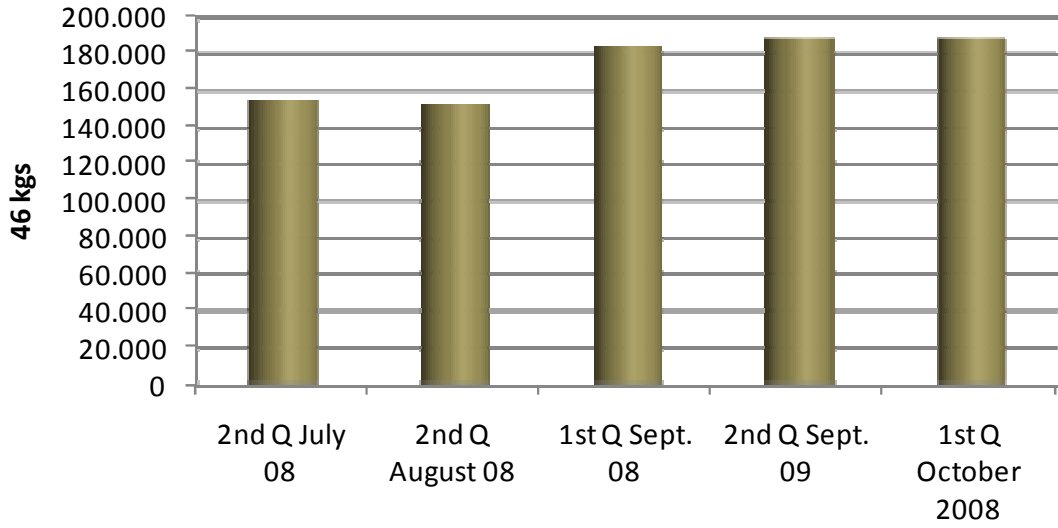
### Amount of coffee fixed during the past 15 days



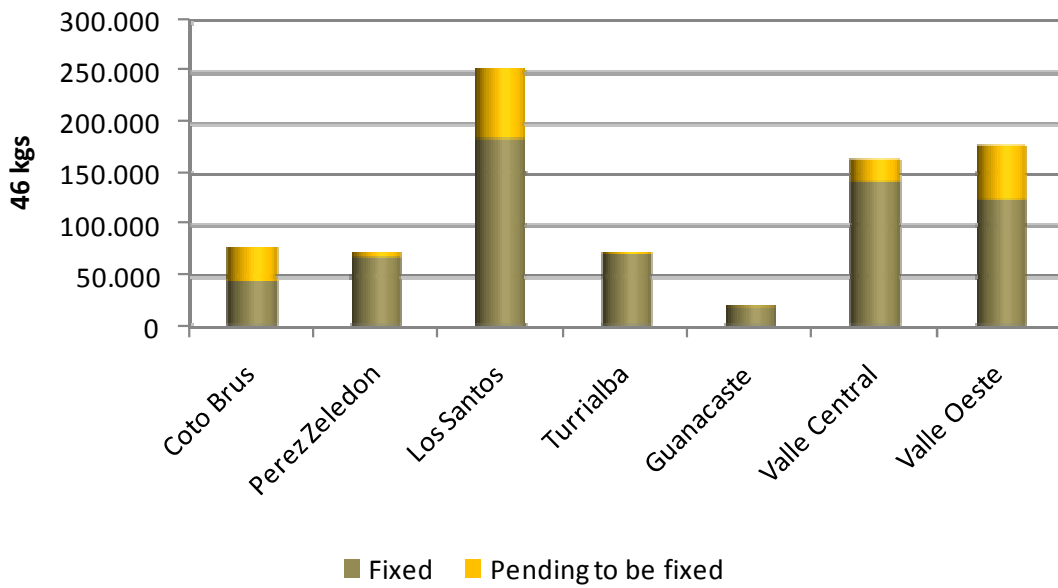
### Total amount of coffee pending to be fixed
