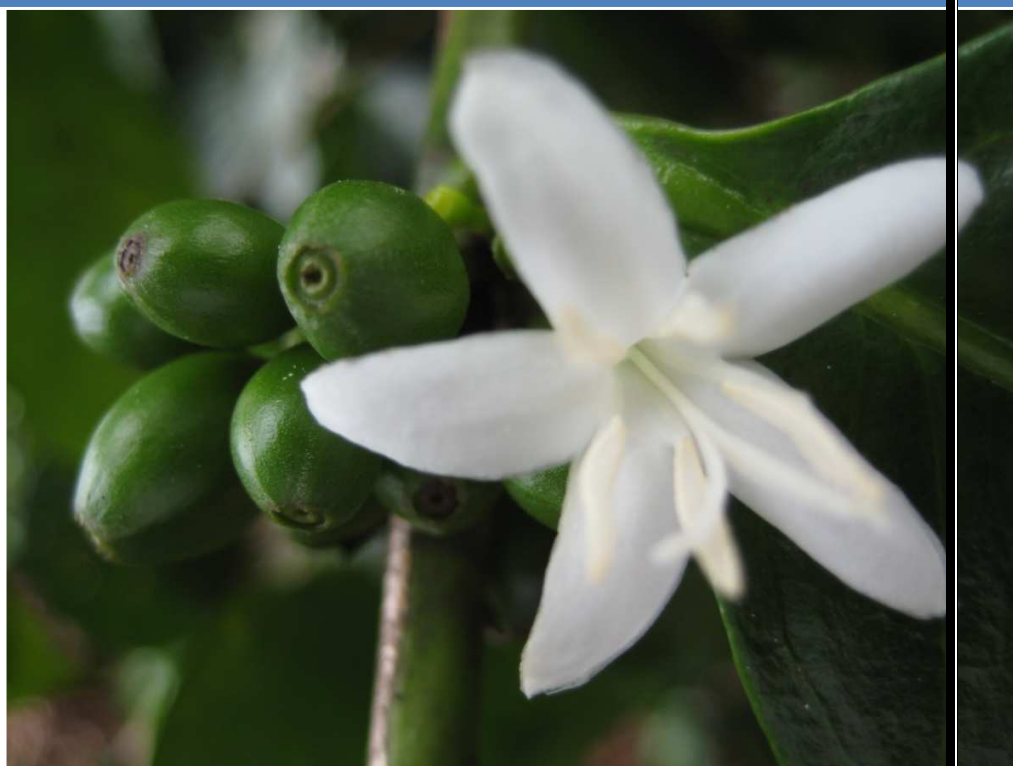




Coffee report – 2008/09 Harvest

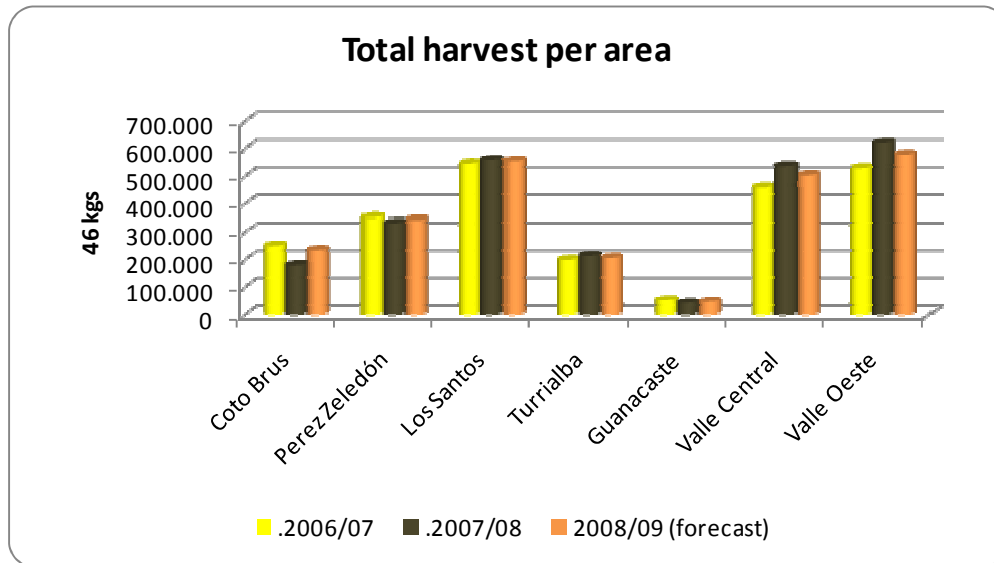


**2nd Quarter of September

New Harvest already began in the south (Coto Brus, Turrialba and Perez Zeledón). First samples for October shipment in our lab for cupping.

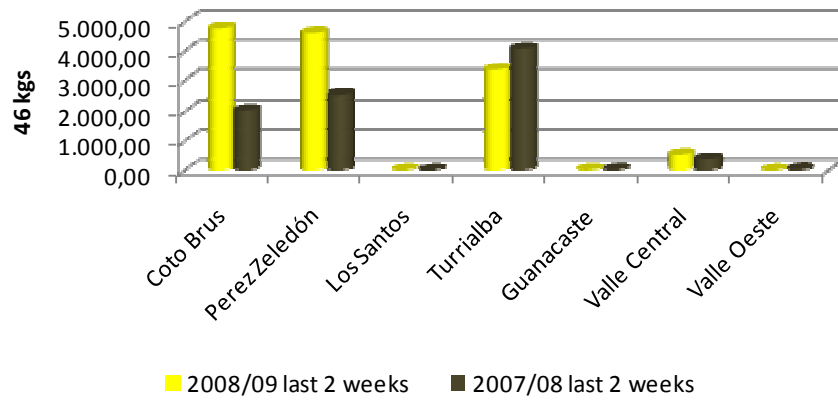
Coto Brus and Perez Zeledón should be up whereas Turrialba is forecasted to be down.



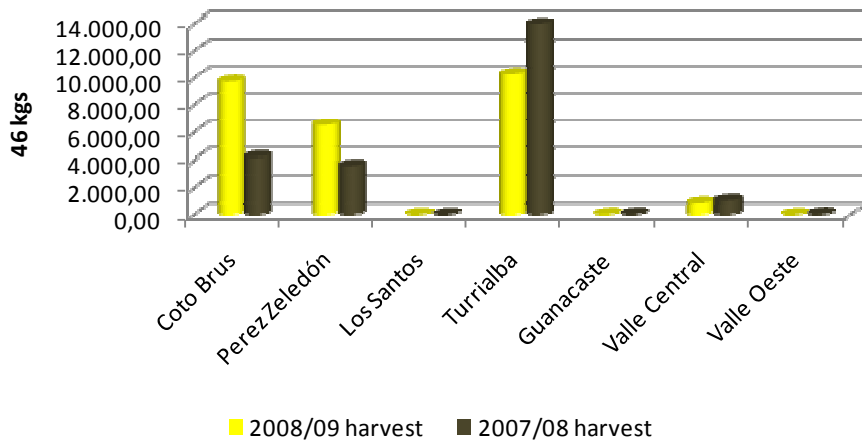

Total delivery of cherry per area vs same date last year



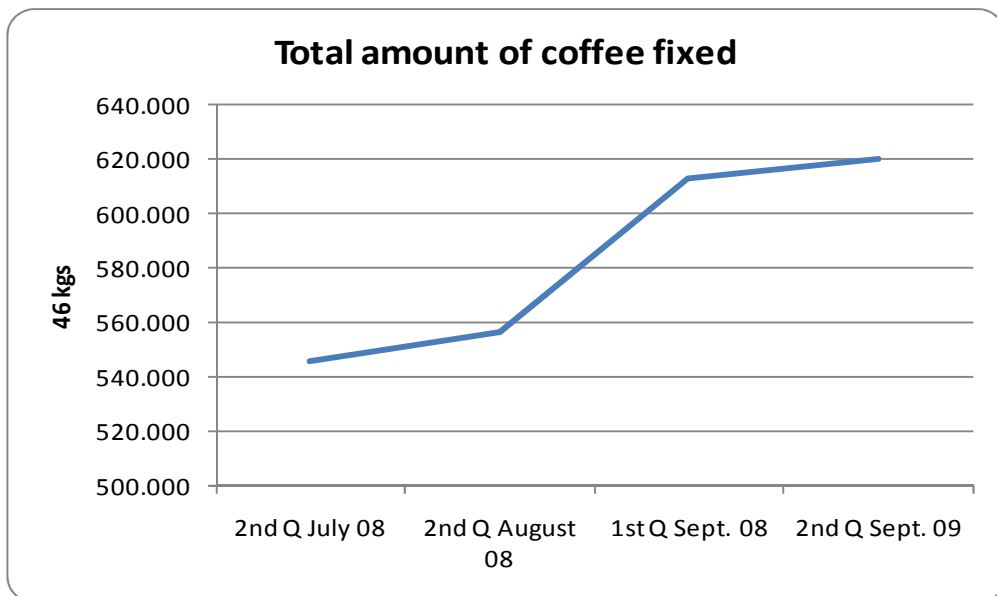
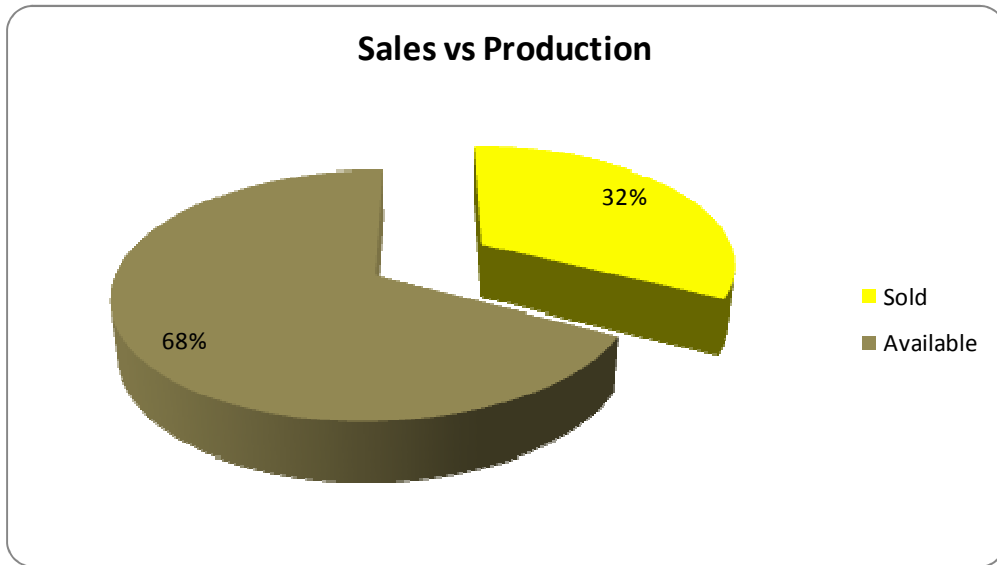
Last 2 weeks delivery vs last year



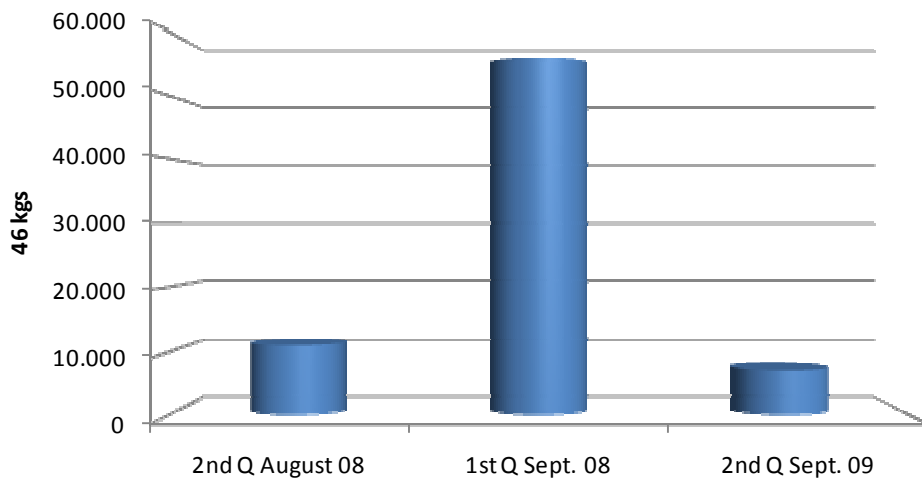
The financing situation is still stressing the sector as even if some credit lines have already been approved, it is still pending to be confirmed when the money will be available.

2. Commercial activity:

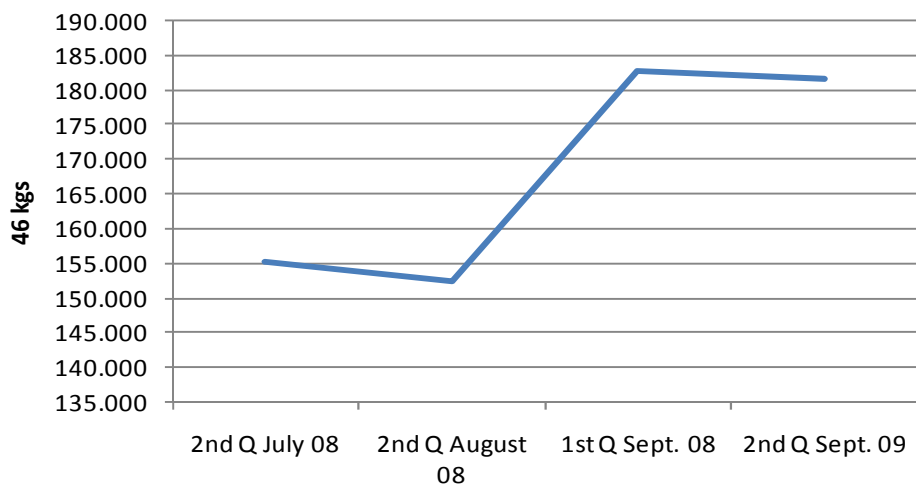
A 32.50% (about 801,651 qq) is already sold. Las 2 weeks have been very quiet and a few price fixing reported.

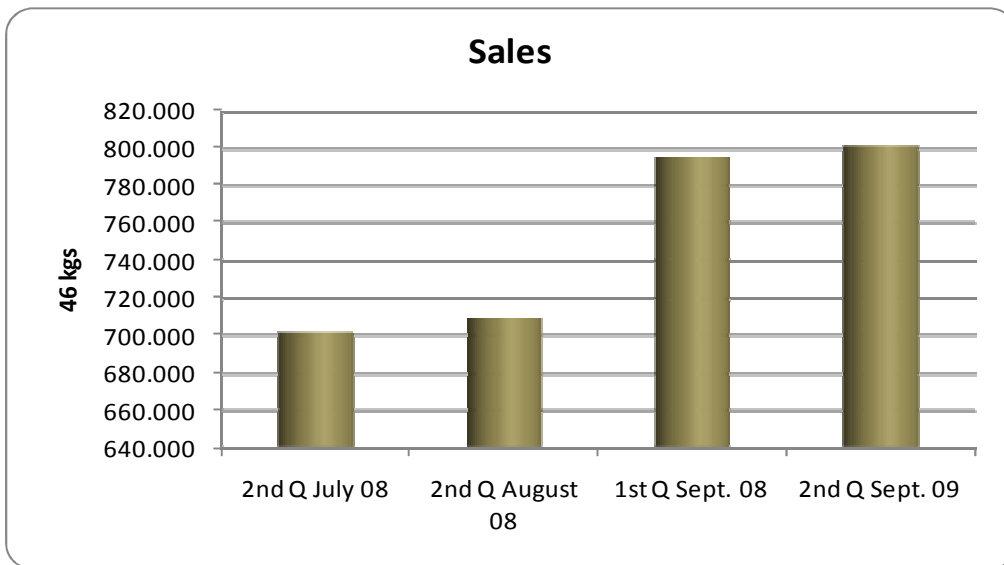


Amount of coffee fixed during the past 15 days

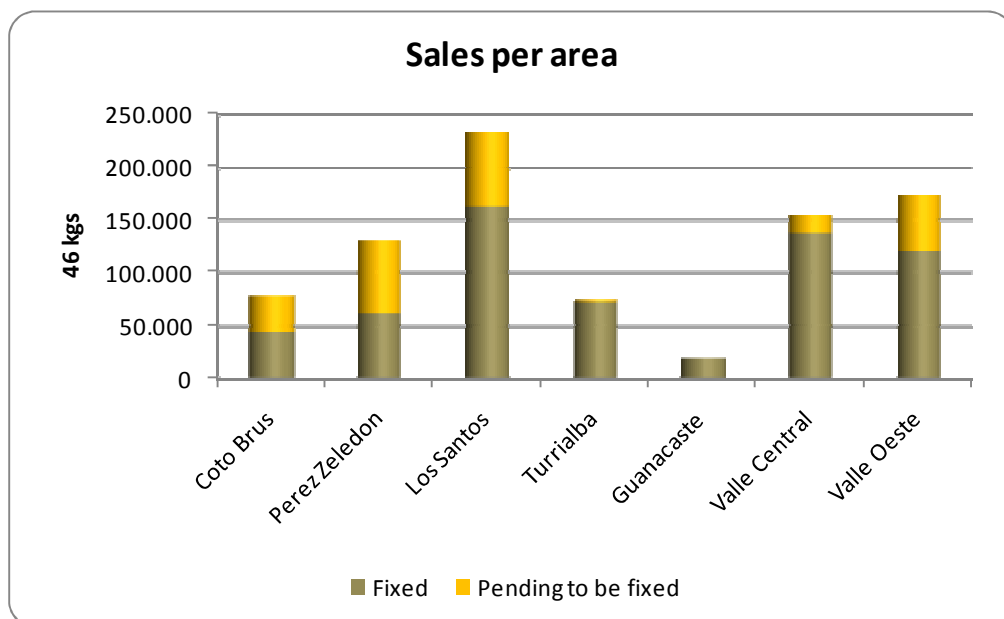


Total amount of coffee pending to be fixed
